## Short Term and Life Members are entitled to:

2. Reduced entry fees for exhibits in the Show.

4. Access to toilet facilities under the Grandstand.
5. Unlimited entry during the Show.
6. Members' Car Parking in the designated area.
7. Entry to facilities and provisions of the Members Bar.

## Junior Members are entitled to:

1. Attend any General Meeting, but not to vote or hold office.
2. Entrance to the Society's Grounds when any function is being held by this Society.
3. Reduced entry fees for exhibits in the Show.
